

# ART ALONG THE ROGUE 2010

## STREET PAINTER APPLICATION

**Festival Dates: October 2 & 3, 2010, "H" Street in Grants Pass, Oregon. Application Deadline: September 15, 2010**

**NEW FOR 2010:** Our theme this year is "animals", meaning artists can, but are not required to, create depiction of animals in art, photos of their pet, or anything concerning animals of any kind.

**LOCATION:** Art Along the Rogue will be held on "H" Street in downtown Grants Pass, OR.

**APPLICATION REVIEW:** The Review Committee will begin its process on August 1, 2010.

Applicants will be notified regarding their acceptance by mid-September.\*

Artists who provide a sponsor will be included as street painters in 2010 but must follow artwork criteria below, however, it is not necessary for artists to find their own sponsors - we will do that for them.

1. Artists must provide a sketch or a color copy of the image you intend to recreate at Art Along the Rogue 2010. Artists will not be accepted without an image of their proposed street painting.
2. Chalk will be provided, however if you are using a predominant color in your design, you may want to purchase that color before the Festival.
3. All street painting spaces are 8 feet x 8 feet square. Spaces must be taped-off with 2 or 3" masking tape (not provided).
4. A street painting seminar with instruction by our featured artist will be held on Friday, October 1st at 6:00 p.m. at the Firehouse Gallery on the corner of 6th and "H" Streets in Grants Pass.

The undersigned artist (guardian if under 18) grants a non-exclusive license to Art Along the Rogue to reproduce, in any medium, his/her art. The undersigned further licenses Art Along the Rogue to re-use, publish and republish photography of the artist (including minors) in any medium. The undersigned artist further grants Art Along the Rogue use of the artist's name (including minors), biographical description and likeness in any media. Art Along the Rogue is not responsible for injuries as a result of street painting.

\*Art Along the Rogue Artist Selection Criteria

1. The sponsors and artists are partners at the festival. The sponsor purchases the space on which the artist will create an image. Because the art created for your square represents the sponsor, it is very important that your subject matter be something that the sponsor will consider a positive partnership. Generally, sponsors do not like to see their name associated with images of violence, gore or major controversy. Art Along the Rogue must consider the sponsors concerns in our selection process.
2. If you are selected as an artist for the 2010 Art Along the Rogue, you must render the image you included with your application form. Any image change must be approved by Art Along the Rogue.
3. Art work must be appropriate for public viewing. No words or symbols intended as advertising may appear within the image. Only chalk/pastels in a solid form may be used for the street painting, no acrylic paints, liquid pastels, etc. are acceptable.
4. Artists are expected to perform both days of the event. Please time your piece so that you finish on Sunday afternoon.
